Community Food SA Inc is a not for profit charity with Christian ethics. Through the Food Centre at Kilburn, it provides low cost groceries to people in need.

The Food Centre was opened on 4 July, 1990 and has nearly 100 volunteers who help in the daily operation. Our mission is to support people physically, emotionally and spiritually in times of financial need.



## WHAT DO WE DO ?

Community Food SA Inc provides over 1,500 lines of groceries including fresh fruits and vegetables, bread, meat, poultry, fish, dairy products and a wide range of essential products.

The Food Centre has complimentary services that support its core service and these include:

### • *Employment Pathways :*

Through work experience and volunteering this program offers participants tangible and transferable skills in the food, hospitality and community services industries.

### • *Cooking Demonstrations :*

In conjunction with Community Foodies, the centre conducts monthly cooking demonstrations giving people real skills and experience in:

- Nutrition and healthy eating messages
- How to eat well on a budget
- How to present food
- Taking the stress out of food shopping

### • *Arnolds Place :*

A low cost cheery coffee shop that is popular with customers and community groups. Arnolds offers low cost snacks, cappuccino, teas and soft drinks as well as freshly made cakes, soups and biscuits.



### • *Food vouchers and food for hampers :*

Community Food SA Inc. accepts food vouchers from welfare organisations and provides groceries to these organisations for emergency food relief.
